Thursday's Group Outing





Awards Banquet Guest Speaker:

Dr. Elliott Johnson Trail Rides Editor/Publisher

We are pleased to have Dr. Elliott Johnson join us as our Awards Banquet Guest

Speaker. Elliott worked as a baseball coach for 40 years (30 years as a collegiate head baseball coach). Upon retirement from coaching, Elliott asked of the Lord, "Please give me a passion like I had coaching." He heard that small, unmistakable whisper telling him how to spread the Word next. He established a non-profit organization for the purpose of publishing athletic and western-related devotional books, tracts, videos, and magazines. (He also teaches horsemanship from Trail Ride Ranch near Waco, Texas.) Elliott believes placing sound, written material in the hands of people is of great value in spreading the Word of God, encouraging believers to share the Gospel, strengthening families and building relationships with other followers of Christ.

Elliott grew up on an 850-acre farm-ranch in Central Nebraska. After leaving the plains for college and coaching in several states, he became one of the most successful baseball coaches in the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics. Elliott was named Coach of the Year 9 times, won 11 conference, district, or national championships, and named to 3 Halls of Fame. He has a Doctor of Arts degree in Physical Education and has authored 30 athletic-related devotional books and 6 baseball videos. The Fellowship of Christian Athletes presented him the 2008 Jerry Kindall Character in Coaching Award.
